1. EVENT MANAGEMENT

Baltic Road Championships 2024 is organised by Estonian Cyclists Union (Tondi 84, Tallinn) in collaboration with Pro Cyclists Club, Latvian Cycling Federation and Lithuanian Cycling Federation.

Baltic Road Championships 2024 is organized according to UCI Regulations from 19th to 22nd June 2024 and includes Lithuanian, Latvian and Estonian national road race championships (UCI CN).

According to UCI regulations (1.2.028) Men and Women Under 23 riders can participate in the separate Under 23 race and in the Elite race. In Elite race they will race for the Elite champion title.

5. REGISTRATION

Registration opens on Friday, May 6 and ends on Thursday, June 13 at 24:00.

6. RANKINGS

The ranking of the competitors will be determined on the basis of the time taken to complete the race. For WE and ME riders UCI points are awarded according to the UCI regulations article 2.10.008 and 2.10.017.

7. RACE CENTRE

On June 18-19 the competition centre will be located in Estonian Road Museum (Varbuse, Kanepi vald 63122 Põlva maakond: Google Maps).

On June 20-22 the competition centre will be located in Competition centre is in Võru centre (Seminari väljak, Võru, 65608 Võru maakond: Google Maps).

8. CONFIRMATION OF STARTERS AND TEAM MANAGERS MEETING

Licenses will be checked at the secretariat on the basis of pre-registration.

For all categories the final confirmation of the starters will take place on:

18 June at 16.00-18:00 in Estonian Road Museum. Athletes can also be confirmed via e-mail ejl@ejl.ee (names and competition classes of the confirmed athletes must be specified in in the mail).

For all categories distribution of competition materials will take place on:

- 18 June at 16.00-18:00 in Estonian Road Museum
- 19 June at 08.00-15.30 in Estonian Road Museum
- 20 June at 09.00-13.30 in Võru centre
- 21 June at 10.00-15.30 in Võru centre
- 22 June at 09.00-13.00 in Võru centre

NB! Competitors who are properly pre-registered and whose absence has not been notified to the general secretary by the team representative during the final confirmation of the starters, will be entered in the official list of starters. According to UCI CR art.1.2.055, a competitor on the official list of starters without a medical certificate is penalized with a fine for not starting.



































Timing chips are issued with start numbers and must be returned to the secretariat immediately after the race. If the chip is lost or not returned, the contestant will be fined €50.

Team managers meeting will be held on June 18 at 19:00 via Teams.

9. NEUTRAL TECHNICAL SUPPORT

The organisers will provide neutral technical assistance for road races.

For the road races the maximum number of team cars in the convoy is 15 per race. For each country there are 5 car places per race. Every federation will present combined team cars to the organising federation's email ejl@ejl.ee by 17 June at 12.00.

The drawing lots for team cars will be held at the end of the team managers meeting 18.06 19.00.

The order of team cars in the race will be determined as follows:

- 1. In between combined list of teams presented to the organizing federation.
- 2. If the number of cars per race is less than 15 and team managers present at the team managers meeting want candidates for the free places a second order will be determined in between these teams.

The driver of the escort car must have a valid UCI licence. The names of the drivers of team cars with their contacts and UCI IDs must be submitted to the PCP. The information about the competition is transmitted through Radio Tour in Zello application.

10. OFFICIAL PRIZE CEREMONY

The winner of the race will be named Baltic champion and will be awarded with a prize from competition partners. The second and the third place winners will be awarded with a prize from competition partners.

Official awards ceremony must be attended by all athletes who have won prizes in their age category. Athletes who do not appear for the award will lose their right to prizes and may be fined in accordance with the UCI regulations.

Riders must take part in the prize ceremony wearing their race clothing. The prize ceremony must not be attended with a hat, headband, glasses or other face-covering accessories.

11. TIME LIMITS

Riders finishing in a time exceeding that of the winner by more than 8% will not be classified. Riders getting lapped by the leader will be eliminated.

12. PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only applicable.

13. ANTI-DOPING

UCI and Estonian anti-doping rules apply to competition, and SA Eesti Antidoping has the right to conduct doping control among all participants. More information at: http://www.antidoping.ee.

Every registered athlete must be ready for doping control. Refusing doping control or evading doping control is considered a doping rule violation. The athlete is obliged to follow the rules of fair play, anti-manipulation of sports competitions and sports security.
