Rules: Competitions are held in accordance with the 2026 Estonian BMX Racing Cup Technical Guide.

REGISTRATION

Registration takes place via the Streamzsports online platform.

- Challenge and Cruiser categories: €20

- Pro Open category: €30

Registration deadline: Wednesday, 20 May 2026 at 23:59

Late registration fee per round:

- Challenge and Cruiser categories: €50

Late registration accepted until: 22 May 2026 at 23:59

Registration service fee: An additional registration service fee applies according to the Streamzsports pricing structure:

- Challenge and Cruiser categories: €3.95

TIMING & TRANSPONDERS

Electronic timing will be used.

Transponders: All riders must use a MyLaps ProChip transponder.

Transponder number: Personal transponder numbers must be entered during registration in the Streamzsports system.

Transponder registration: All riders must report to the race secretary on both race mornings to register their transponder.

Rental: Riders without a personal transponder may rent one during registration via the Streamzsports platform.

Rental fee: €5 per day

Collection / Return: Rental transponders will be issued to the team manager (or their designated person) at the race office on Saturday, 23 May, between 10:00–10:15.

All rented transponders must be returned by the team manager after the conclusion of Sunday's race. Failure to return a transponder will result in a contractual penalty of €200 per transponder.

Result recording: A rider's result is only guaranteed if they finish with correctly mounted number plates and a functioning transponder.

BALANCE BIKE RACE

A balance bike race will be held for the youngest riders. With prior approval from the commissaire, assistance is permitted where necessary to ensure rider safety. However, riders may not be pushed forward.

Registration: No pre-registration is required. Please be present at least 15 minutes before the start.

Format: This is a fun-format race for the youngest members of the BMX family. The start will be given from the last roller on the third straight, and the race continues to the finish line. All participants must wear a helmet. All participants will receive a small souvenir after the race.

The awards ceremony will take place no earlier than 15 minutes after the final.

The schedule may be adjusted according to organisational needs. Any changes will be communicated on site by the official event commentator or race secretary.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Open practice: On Friday, 22 May, the track will be open for practice from 17:00–20:00. Track fee: €10 per rider, payable in cash on site. No medical services will be available during Friday practice.

Communication: Team managers will be added to a shared WhatsApp group no later than the Team Managers' Meeting. Operational information, schedule updates and other important notices will be shared via this group. Club representatives are kindly requested to actively monitor it throughout the race weekend.

Café and shop: A café will be available on site with cash payment only. A BMX equipment sales tent will also be available.

Medical: A Tallinn Ambulance paramedic team will be present trackside on both race days from the start of practice until the conclusion of the competition. Medical personnel will be located between the first and third corners of the track.
